Why we want you: The Eden is truly a paradise on earth, with a wide variety of wildlife, landscapes and features that we would love to be able to share with our audiences to:

- Encourage people to visit and enjoy their local river,
- Increase their knowledge of the special wildlife, features and places found in the Eden Valley, and to
- Change perceptions about the river, and motivate people to care for the river and its fragile habitats.

However, our picture library is out of date, and is missing good quality photographs (taken throughout the year) of a large number of the species of wildlife found in the Eden, as well as Eden's key landmarks and features.

We would love to hear from amateur photographers who can take great photos that share our passion for Eden's rivers, landscapes and wildlife!

Requirements: An interest in the environment and the outdoors – happy to photograph whatever the weather!
Ideally you will own photography equipment, but we do have a couple of SLR cameras you could borrow.

We will provide you with a list of things we would like photographed and will brief you on the types of photos

we would like. You can cherry-pick which ones you would like to capture based on your interests and schedule.

All photographs taken by you would be copyright of Eden Rivers Trust, but naturally we will credit you on every image we use.

Photographs may be used online/in traditional media for promotional or educational purposes.

What's in it for you: This role is one that is intended to fit easily into your current lifestyle and is a great chance to showcase and hone your photography skills whilst enjoying the great outdoors here in the Eden.
You could see your photos used on social media, in print or even as part of an exhibition!
