

# Photo Perspectives Activity Sheet



Take a fresh look at the river to see what you can find!

## You will need

- a camera or camera mobile phone
- a set of 'different perspective' cards

**1** Pick a 'different perspective' card and then take a photo using that perspective - it could be 'from above', 'from below', 'up close' or 'the big picture'.



## Note to Parents

Make sure your child takes more than one photo of each perspective so that they have a selection and can then pick their favourite.

**2** When you've got the photo you want, then pick another 'perspective card' and take another photo using that perspective.



**3** Keep going until you've used up all your 'perspective cards'.

**4** Now flick through your selection of photos and pick out:

- your favourite perspective
- the most unusual perspective
- the funniest perspective




## Take it further
