

River Reflections Activity Sheet



See how many different reflections you can spot down at the river

You will need

- a camera or camera mobile phone
- a set of River Reflections cards

1 Pick a **River Reflections card** and then see if you can spot this reflection in the river. It might be a reflection of a natural or man-made feature, a small object, or a large landscape.



Note to Parents

Encourage your child to take more than one photo of each type of reflection so that they have a selection to choose from when picking their favourite.

2 When you've got the photo you want, pick another **River Reflections card** and take a photo of that type of reflection.



3 Keep going until you've used up all your **River Reflections cards**.

4 Now flick through your selection of photos and pick out:

- the most beautiful reflection
- the weirdest reflection
- the most amazing reflection

Take it further

When you get home, why not edit your photos using Pixlr or Camera2 - see how crazy you can make your reflections!

Or

Print your photos and make a photo-montage to put in a scrap book, journal or photo frame as a reminder of your visit to the river.




