- Putting up a sturdy <u>fence</u> near the river, helps to create a <u>buffer</u> <u>strip</u>, which protects the river from things that aren't very good for it, like <u>cows</u> and sheep who damage the riverbank, eating the <u>plants</u> and trampling <u>soil</u> into the water.
- Buffer Strips also help reduce the amount of farmland
 pollution from fertilisers and pesticides from reaching the river.
- River creatures need plenty of <u>oxygen</u> in the water so that they can breathe and survive.
- Where rivers have been <u>straightened</u> in the past, they are usually all the same depth and speed and there is less <u>habitat</u> for the different river creatures to live.
- Healthy rivers have natural <u>meanders</u> and a mix of shallow <u>fast _ flowing</u> and deep <u>slow _ flowing</u> areas of water, where plants can grow and a variety of river creatures can live.
- **6.** Healthy river systems help to slow the flow of water, which can help reduce flooding further downstream.
